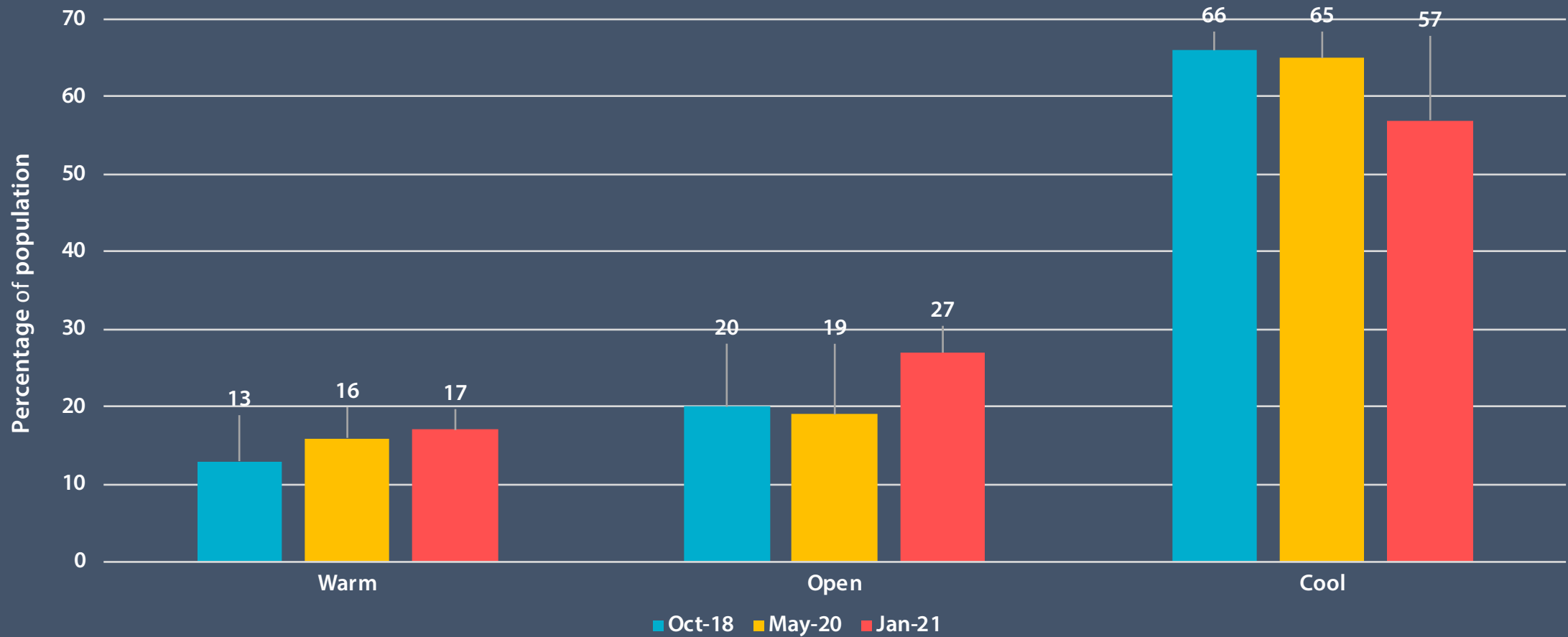

# A changing spiritual landscape?

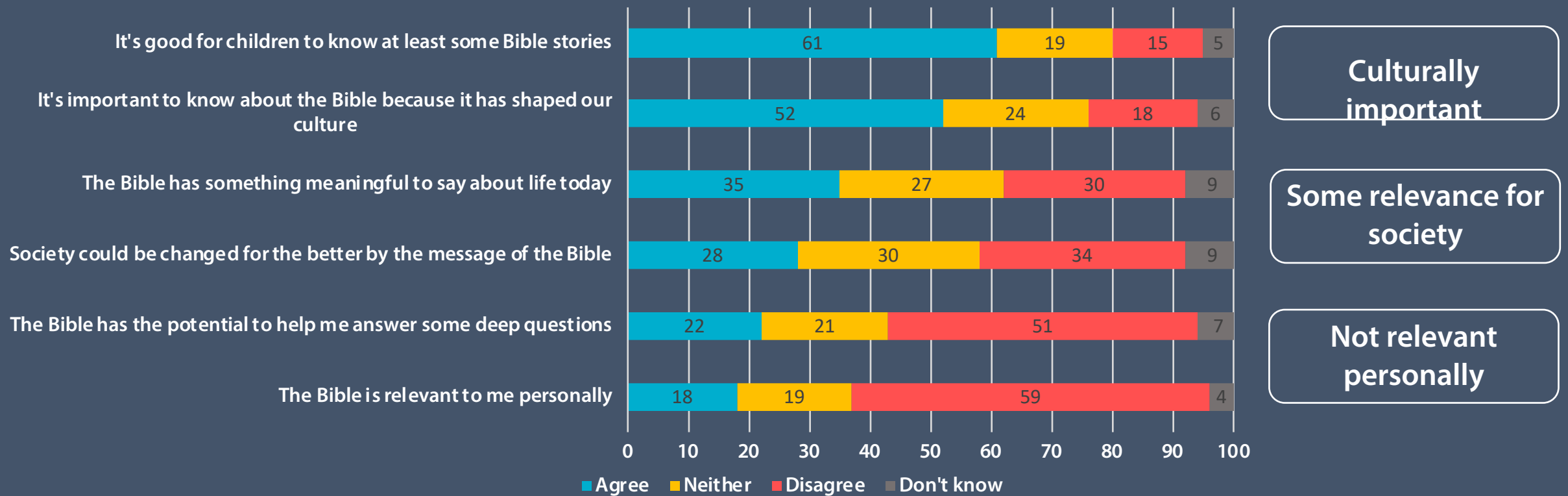

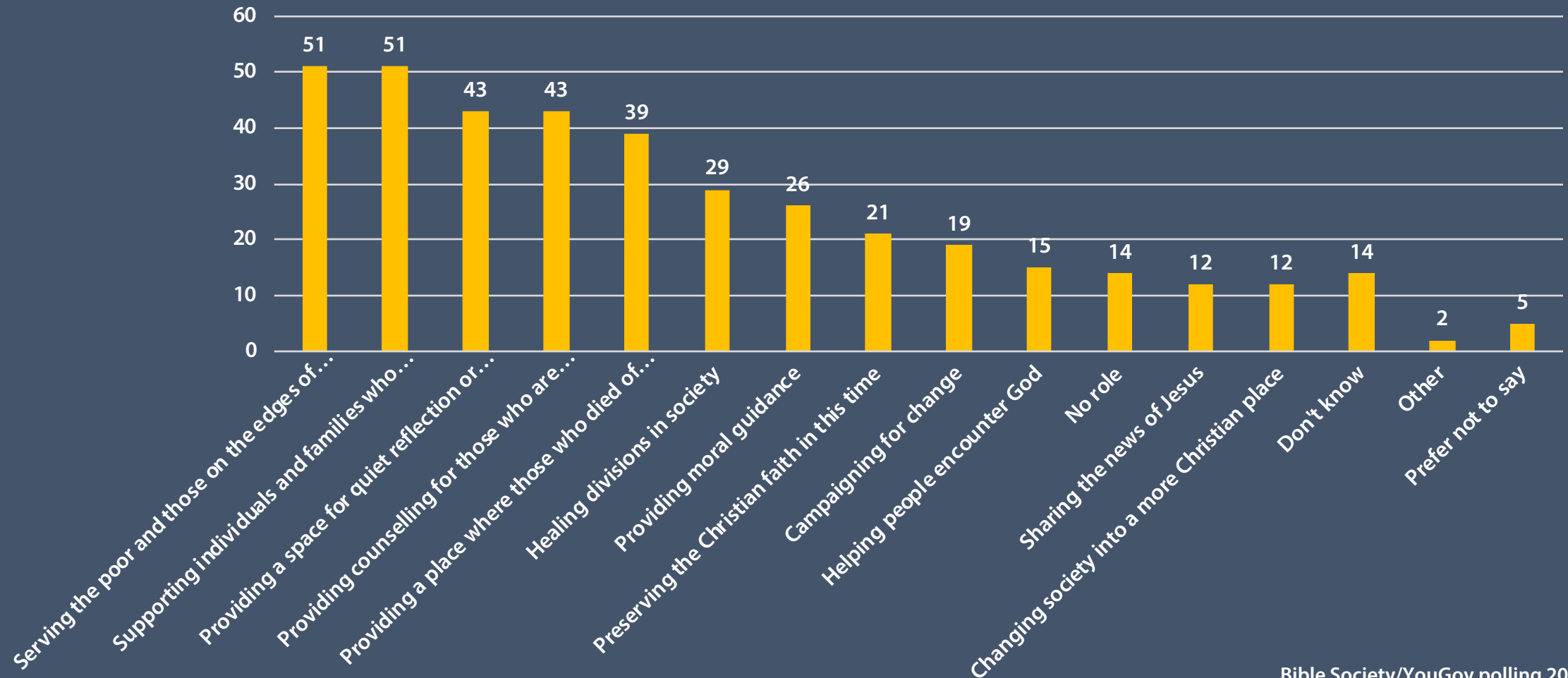

# Methodology notes

## October 2018

All figures, unless otherwise stated, are from YouGov plc. Total sample size was 19,101 adults. Fieldwork was undertaken between 11 October and 13 November 2018. The survey was carried out online. The figures have been weighted and are representative of all England/Wales adults (aged 18+).

## May 2020

All figures, unless otherwise stated, are from YouGov plc. Total sample size was 2,226 adults. Fieldwork was undertaken between 26 May and 5 June 2020. The survey was carried out online. The figures have been weighted and are representative of all UK adults (aged 18+).

## January 2021

All figures, unless otherwise stated, are from YouGov plc. Total sample size was 3,182 adults. Fieldwork was undertaken between 5 and 18 January 2021. The survey was carried out online. The figures have been weighted and are representative of all English and Welsh adults (aged 18+).
